**In 2019, the LSPA's Key Accomplishments Include:**

- Sending MassDEP a [cover letter](#) and [extensive comments](#) during the public comment period on the 2019 Proposed Amendments to the MCP.
- Forming a PFAS Task Force for participation in a variety of PFAS-related efforts including providing MassDEP with comments on its proposed MCL, participating at DEP Office Hours in discussions about DEP's PFAS private well sampling initiative, and beginning to draft PFAS Q & As for MassDEP consideration.
- Developing and releasing our second [on-demand course](#) for DEP credit.
- [Advocating with state legislators](#) for an LSP and a toxicologist to sit on the state's interagency PFAS Task Force.
- Offering over 12 courses for LSP credit, including three offerings of “*LNAPL Regulatory Change, Guidance, and Progress*” for 4 DEP credits.
- Hosting over 300 attendees at our [Annual Dinner](#) at Mechanics Hall in Worcester.
- Holding a [member meeting presentation](#) on “*Asbestos in Soil- Hidden in Plain Sight*,” and preparing to raise this issue with MassDEP leadership.
- Offering six member meetings for LSP credit in Springfield, MA.
- Testifying in support of the LSPA's home heating oil insurance bill ([S. 594](#)), and facilitating [NBC10 TV coverage](#) of the issue.
